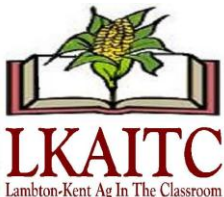

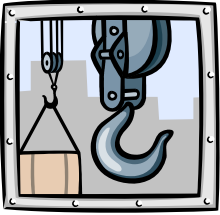

## Turning Rocks into Food

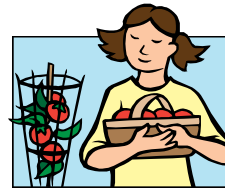


Find out how rocks and minerals transform into the food we eat.
